- Provide information and “trouble-shooting” services for anyone who is interested in bats or who finds they have bats roosting in their house (bats and their roosts have legal protection and Natural England must be consulted prior to any action which might affect a site used by bats, e.g. building work);
- Train and develop licensed roost visitors from the membership in order to provide the above service;

Of the eighteen species of bats in Britain fifteen occur in Oxfordshire. The Oxfordshire Bat Group is active in field surveys and roost creation projects and runs an annual programme of talks and field work.
